Manager's Memo

We're continuing to wind down the upgrade at the wastewater treatment facility. It is coming together very quickly in the final months. We are working through some final issues, but are still on target to meet the January 1, 2011 requirement. The Town of New Market still anticipates connecting to the system in mid December. We will have an "open house" in the spring once everything settles down and the weather breaks, so that the public can see first-hand what has transpired over the last couple of years. It is truly a state of the art facility that will serve the region for many years to come.

The new Springbrook Road bridge project continues to move forward as well. VDOT is currently in the right-of-way acquisition phase of this project, and construction is still officially slated for early 2013. We will continue to keep you updated on this very important project.

Finally, you may have heard that the Town was recently donated four acres of land along Linville Creek from developer Greg Turner. This property is located on the south side of Turner Avenue, just across from Heritage Park. It is the Town's intentions to develop this into additional public recreational space in the future.

TRASH PICK-UP REMINDER

Curbside trash and recycling is picked up each Monday.

Yard waste is picked up on the first Tuesday of each month. Reminder: 5 units maximum allowable to be picked up. 1 unit is defined as 1 trash can or bundle (not exceeding 75 lbs). Loose items must be bundled and tied; a maximum of 4' long and 2" in diameter.
