Bids will be received at the Office of the Town Manager, Town of Broadway, 116 Broadway Avenue, Broadway, Virginia 22815.
- B. Project Description: Approximately 2,500 feet of 21-inch PVC and 18-inch ductile iron effluent line, 12 manholes, a trenchless crossing of VA Route 211, a crossing of the North Fork Shenandoah River, and a headwall outfall into the river.

- H. Project may be funded by a loan from the Virginia Clean Water Revolving Fund and a grant from the Water Quality Improvement fund. Contractor shall comply with Equal Employment Opportunity, Affirmative Action, and Small and Minority / Women's Business Utilization requirements of the Virginia Clean Water Revolving Fund, as defined in the Project Manual.
